

COVID-19 Bluebird Statement as of June 3, 2020

We would like our friends, staff, and customers of the Bluebird to know that we take our Covid protection/prevention very seriously. We are fortunate to have access to the most up-to-date information from the State of Michigan, the Leelanau/Benzie Health Department, the National Restaurant Assn, Michigan Restaurant Assn, and other sources. We monitor our staff and their health, including daily health checklists and questionnaires. We require masks, gloves, and sanitization procedures in order to keep us all safe. We will continue to update our information, and will proceed with the utmost caution when adding to our schedule and menu changes, as well as considering when to open parts of our outdoor or indoor public dining areas. Thank you for putting your trust in us and our staff.

1. Face masks are required upon entry to our service area.
2. You will be asked some health questions before entering. (We will try and not invade your privacy)
3. Seating is first come, first served
4. All seating is 100% outside. (This may change as time progresses, indoor seating will be 50% when are able.)
5. No groups over 6 permitted at a single table. Larger groups will be asked to be divided into multiple tables.
6. Entrance and Exit shall be escorted to your table, as well as to the restroom.
7. All service ware is 100% disposable at this time, and we may ask your help in depositing them in our container prior to leaving.
8. Guests are **required** to wear a facemask when not at their table. Guests may take off their mask when they are seated at their table.
9. Social distancing guidelines must be followed at all times.
10. Walking the grounds, to the restroom, entering/exiting is prohibited without an escort.
11. Co-mingling, moving/combining furniture is not permitted. Gathering anywhere outside of your table is not permitted.
12. Rest Room - 1 person allowed in rest room at one time unless to accompany a child. Masks must be worn while in the restroom, and you must wash your hands before exiting.
13. Any guests that choose not to follow these guidelines will be asked to leave for the safety of our other guests and staff.

We are very happy to have you join us! We appreciate your patience and understanding of our rules and restrictions. We hope to have indoor seating as soon as possible, but in the meantime, please enjoy what we have to offer, and thank you for following our guidelines.
